

# Easter Egg Cosy Knit



## Crochet Easter Crème Egg cover:

### Stitches used:

- Chain (ch)
- Slip stitch (sl st)
- Double crochet (dc) – UK terms
- Increasing

### You will need:

- DK yarn (any Easter colour)
- 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

### Tension:

Not important – just crochet fairly tightly so the egg fits snugly.

### Pattern (worked in continuous rounds)

#### Round 1

- Make a **magic ring**
- 6 dc into the ring  
(6 stitches)

#### Round 2

- 2 dc into each stitch around  
(12 stitches)

#### Round 3

- 1 dc, 2 dc in next stitch – repeat around  
(18 stitches)

#### Round 4

- Dc in each stitch around  
(18 stitches)

#### Round 5

- Dc in each stitch around  
(18 stitches)

#### Round 6

- Dc in each stitch around  
(18 stitches)

At this point, **try slipping your Crème Egg inside.**

If it's tight, add one more round of dc.

### Round 6 (optional decorative edge)

- Slip stitch, chain 2 – repeat around for a simple scalloped edge

OR

- Just slip stitch around for a neat finish.  
Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Optional Easter variations:

- **Chick:** Add tiny embroidered eyes and a small orange triangle beak
- **Bunny:** Sew on two small chain-and-dc ears
- **Flower top:** Add a round of picots at the top edge
- **Drawstring:** Chain 40 and weave through top stitches
