

# Easter Egg Cosy Knit



## Knitted Easter Creme Egg cover

### Techniques used:

- Cast on
- Knit stitch
- Purl stitch
- Knit 2 together (*k2tog*)

### You will need:

- DK yarn (any Easter colour)
- 3.75 mm knitting needles (straight or circular)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

### Tension:

Not critical. Knit fairly snugly so the egg stays secure.

### Pattern notes:

- This pattern is knitted **flat** and then **seamed**
- Uses **stocking stitch** (knit one row, purl one row)
- Instructions are written row by row

### Knitting pattern:

#### Cast On

Cast on **24 stitches**

Rows 1-4 (K1,P1) repeat to end

Rows 5-14

- Row 1: Knit
- Row 2: Purl

Repeat these 2 rows.

You should now have a small rectangle.

Wrap it gently around your Creme Egg to check the fit – it should meet edge to edge.

### Shaping the top:

Row 15: *K2tog, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog* (22 stitches)

Row 16: Purl

Row 17: *K2tog, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog* (20 stitches)

Row 18: Purl

Row 19: *K2tog across* (10 stitches)

Leave a long tail for sewing and pull through remaining 10 stitches.

### Making up

Fold the piece in half **right sides together**

Sew the side seam using mattress stitch or backstitch.

Pop your Creme Egg inside.

### Optional Easter variations

**Striped egg:** Change colour every 2–4 rows

**Bunny version:** Sew on two small, knitted ears
