



2027 TCS London Marathon – Shooting Star Children’s Hospices Charity Place Terms & Conditions

Definitions

“Shooting Star Children’s Hospices/ We/ Us/ Our” means Shooting Star Children’s Hospices (registered charity number 1042495) of Shooting Star House, The Avenue, Hampton, Middlesex, TW12 3RA. The Charity that has reserved Your place in the Event.

“You/ Your/ Yourself” means the person agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions and who is using the Shooting Star Children’s Hospices place to take part in an event.

“Event” means the TCS London Marathon.

“Event Organiser” means the company London Marathon Events Limited (company number 01528489) responsible for organising the TCS London Marathon.

1. Participation

- i. You acknowledge that participation in the Event may be physically demanding and You are aware of the nature of the Event and associated medical and physical risks involved.
- ii. You agree that you are physically capable of taking part in the Event and agree to be solely responsible for your actions. Shooting Star Children’s Hospices are not responsible for any injury or illness that You may suffer as a result of Your participation in the Event.
- iii. The minimum age of entry is 18 years at the date of the Event.
- iv. You have read, agree to and accept the Event Organiser’s General Conditions of Entry. To the extent there is any conflict with these terms and conditions, the terms and conditions of the General Conditions of Entry shall prevail.

2. Bookings, Payments and Your obligations

- i. Applications must be made by completing the Shooting Star Children’s Hospices Application Form. On successful application you will submit payment of the Entry Fee of £100. You may also be required to register Your place on the Event directly with the Event Organiser.
- ii. You shall not be eligible to participate in the Event and no bidding contract shall exist between You and Us until We have provided You with written confirmation that the application was successful and full payment of the Entry Fee has been received.
- iii. Your charity place is exclusively for you and is non-transferable. You may not offer your place to someone else under any circumstances.
- iv. To take part in the Event, you pledge to raise the amount stated in your application or £3,000, whichever is the greater figure, and excluding Gift Aid. You agree to pay all sponsorship to Shooting Star Children’s Hospices within 2 months of the date of the Event.

- v. You also agree to:
 - i. Comply with any rules or regulations relating to the Event as We or the Event Organiser may notify You of from time to time.
 - ii. Follow all instructions given to Us, the Event Organisers and any of Our or the Event Organisers' agents, employees or workers, or any referees, stewards or other event officials in respect to the Event

- 3. Withdrawal, Cancellations or Alterations
 - i. The Entry Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable to other persons or event year under any circumstances. The decision of Shooting Star Children's Hospices is final.
 - ii. You acknowledge that Shooting Star Children's Hospices places are limited, and payment of the Entry Fee and reservation of the place impacts expenditure and charity income of Shooting Star Children's Hospices. Notice of withdrawal from the Event must be communication by emailing events@shootingstar.org.uk or writing to Events Team, Shooting Star Children's Hospices, Shooting Star House, The Avenue, Hampton, Middlesex, KT12 3RA.
 - iii. All charity place deferrals are at Shooting Star Children's Hospice's absolute discretion and are not guaranteed. All deferral requests must be communicated in writing by emailing events@shootingstar.org.uk as soon as possible.
 - iv. The following rules apply when deferring:
 - i. If you have raised a minimum of 50% of your pledge and haven't deferred on a previous occasion, you will be offered a deferral to the 2028 Event.
 - ii. If you have not hit a minimum of 50% of your pledge but have raised something and have requested a deferral before the London Marathon console closing date, we will review your request taking into consideration the amount you've raised and the reason for deferral.
 - iii. If you have not raised anything and/or ask to defer once the console has closed, we will not be able to offer you a deferral to the 2028 Event and ask that you re-apply.
 - iv. If you have deferred on a previous occasion, we cannot offer you a deferral for another year and we ask that you re-apply.
 - v. If you are offered a deferral, Your registration fee is not refundable and you will be asked to re-pay Your Entry Fee to secure your place in the 2028 Event.
 - vi. Any money you have raised can also be rolled over to count towards your fundraising in the 2028 Event.
 - v. If you have a ballot place, you will need to contact the Event Organisers directly to discuss their deferral process.
 - vi. Places in the Event are strictly limited and are subject to availability. We may refuse entry if:
 - i. We consider that your participation in the Event will bring the Event, the Event Organiser or Shooting Star Children's Hospices into disrepute or otherwise

- damage the reputation of Shooting Star Children's Hospices, the Event or the Event Organiser
- ii. The Event Organiser refuses entry at any time
 - iii. In our reasonable opinion you appear unlikely to be able to participate in the Event due to injury, illness or incapacitation
4. Fundraising
- i. You will only use lawful means to fundraise in aid of Shooting Star Children's Hospices and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm Our reputation.
 - ii. You will comply with any fundraising guidance or advice issues by Us.
 - iii. You will make clear to everyone supporting your fundraising you are raising funds 'in aid of' Shooting Star Children's Hospices.
 - iv. You acknowledge that You are responsible for any independent fundraising events carried out. You are fully responsible for organising the events in aid of Shooting Star Children's Hospices and We do not accept liability for any such event.
5. Images, Video and Audio
- i. Any photos, video, audio or quotes taken by Us at the Event may be used to inspire future fundraisers and promote our events. If you don't want to be featured, please let Us know by emailing events@shootingstar.org.uk
 - ii. Please read the Event Organisers privacy statement carefully as they may also use your image for television and film of the Event. We have no control over this as it will be in accordance with their privacy statement.
6. Data and Your Privacy
- i. You acknowledge that you will be contacted via email, phone and post in relation to the Event.
 - ii. The information You have provided will be treated confidentially and We will only share necessary details with the Event Organisers for your successful participation in the Event.
